Oil & Gas Regulatory Authority (OGRA) is regulating mid & downstream oil sector under OGRA Ordinance and the Pakistan Oil (Refining, Blending, Transportation, Storage and Marketing) Rules, 2016. In pursuance of its functions with respect to quality testing, OGRA needs the services of reputable third party surveyor for sampling of petroleum products (liquid fuels) at import level (from ships/ cargoes at Karachi ports) in accordance with relevant ASTM method. Applicant firms/ companies having at least 5 years of relevant experience in such type of sampling may apply.

TERMS OF REFERENCE FOR HIRING THE SERVICES OF THIRD PARTY SURVEYORS FOR SAMPLING OF PETROLEUM PRODUCTS FROM SHIPS/ CARGOES

The Third Party Surveyor will be required to carry out the sampling of petroleum products (liquid fuels) at import level (from ships/ cargoes at Karachi ports) in accordance with relevant ASTM method in the presence of authorized representatives of importer Company and Hydrocarbon Development Institute of Pakistan (HDIP) (as and when assigned by the Authority from time to time) and hand over the sample to the representative of a laboratory (other than HDIP), approved by OGRA for subsequent testing of the same.

Deliverables: Third Party Surveyor will report OGRA after completion of the task on the same day.

Payment Schedule: Fee to be charged from the concerned importer company, as determined by the Authority from time to time.
