AWARENESS CAMPAIGN FOR GENERAL PUBLIC REGARDING SAFE USAGE OF LPG / FUELING OF LPG VEHICLES

Liquefied Petroleum Gas (**LPG**) is a popular form of Energy. It is highly inflammable and can pose serious safety hazards, if not handled properly. Therefore, for safety reasons the Federal Government vide S.R.O. 1068(I)/2013 dated 18th December 2013 amended certain clauses of LPG (Production and Distribution) Rules, 2001. Appendix V Clause 4 (e) of the notified LPG (Production and Distribution) Rules, 2001 is reproduced below:

- (i) For safety reasons, installation of LPG cylinder or tank on motorcycles, scooters and public service vehicles i.e. three wheelers, buses, coaches and wagons shall not be allowed and treated as illegal; and
- No LPG cylinder (ii) shall be installed beneath the seats and within the passenger compartment of vehicle. The licensee shall ensure that vehicles having LPG cylinders installed beneath the seats and within the passenger compartment vehicle shall not be refueled or entertained.

DIRECTIONS FOR ALL LPG LICENCE HOLDERS

The Federal Government vide abovementioned S.R.O. banned the filling of Public Service Vehicles (PSVs) i.e. three wheelers, buses, coaches and wagons with LPG fuel. Therfore, all LPG licenses are directed to strictly comply with LPG (Production and Distribution) Rules, 2001.
