### **Harsh winter ahead?**

EDITORIAL: Pakistan appears to be moving inexorably towards yet another winter of discontent with dimensions outpacing previous winters. While in previous years domestic gas supply and demand were upset as winter approached, today the issue is also one of inexplicable delays in import of LNG - an issue evident for the second year running with the Petroleum Division and Oil and Gas Regulatory Authority (Ogra) audit 2020-21 maintaining that delay in floating tenders for import of LNG spot cargoes led to higher rates resulting in losses of 10.6 billion rupees.
