Cross-subsidy on gas

The Senate passed three government bills — two pertaining to amendments in the Oil and Gas Regulatory Authority Ordinance (Ogra) and one on Allied Health Professional Council Bill — raising questions about the ability of the Opposition to demonstrate its majority once again in the Senate rather than on the content of the bills or on the government's failure to once again follow procedure laid down in the constitution.

WACOG: about time!

WACOG (weighted average cost of gas) bill has been passed by the Senate. This is a landmark achievement, which would allow the government to mix the imported RLNG and domestic gas and converge the pricing. RLNG would no more be ringfenced. Through another Ogra amendment bill, the authorities must fully recover the cost of the gas, while the discretionary power would remain with the federal government on pricing different sectors.
