## **PUBLIC HEARING NOTICE**

Notice of Public Hearing by the Authority to consider Sui Southern Gas Company Limited (SSGCL)'s request for review of its Estimated Revenue Requirement/Prescribed Prices for F.Y. 2022-23

Sui Southern Gas Company Limited (the petitioner) has filed a petition on October 14, 2022, before the Authority under Section 8(2) of the Oil & Gas Regulatory Authority Ordinance, 2002 read with Rule 4(3) of Natural Gas Tariff Rules, 2002 for Review of its Estimated Revenue Requirement / Prescribed Prices for F.Y. 2022-23. The petitioner has projected a shortfall in revenue requirement for FY 2022-23 at Rs. 184,881 million including Rs. 33,787 million of un-recoup shortfall for F.Y. 2021-2022, seeking increase in average prescribed price by Rs 667.44 per MMBTU in its prescribed prices effective from July 01, 2022 to compensate for increase in cost of gas and other components of the petition.

The cost of gas is linked to the international price of crude oil / fuel oil in accordance with the agreements between the Federal Government and the Gas Producers. The breakup of projected prescribed prices as claimed by the petitioner for FY 2022-23 is as under;
