Gas firms directed to resolve issues

ISLAMABAD. Federal Ombudsman Ejaz Ahmad Qureshi has directed Sui Northern Gas Pipelines Limited (SNGPL) and Sui Southern Gas Company Limited (SSCCL) to make a more responsive and effective mechanism to deal with citizen complaints. He was presiding a high-level meeting on Sunday to discuss the working of gas companies and their administrative arrangements to address citizens' complaints. The meeting was attended by the Secretary Petroleum Capt. (R) Muhammad Mahmood, Chairman Oil and Gas Regulatory Authority (OGRA) Masroor Khan, MD SNGPL Ali Javaid Hamdani and MD SSGCL Imran Maniar.
